Site rectification for resin and knot staining

Resinous timber exudation is most likely to occur on south facing elevations and on dark surfaces when the heat of the sun liquifies and mobilises the resin, drawing it to the surface.

The best remedial treatment is to allow the resin to weather until it dries and oxidises, forming a white crystalline powder. The dried resin can then be removed with a stiff nylon or natural bristle brush, and any remaining residues washed off with a cloth.
