Teknofloor Aqua is a single-component paint for concrete and wooden floors. It is an easy to use and durable paint solution for floors in homes, public spaces and storage facilities exposed to light traffic. A semi-gloss finish makes the floor look tranquil and stylish.

Teknofloor Aqua is easy and quick to apply using a roller or a brush. The surface dries quickly, allowing further layers to be applied after four hours, so the work can be completed in one day.

Teknofloor Aqua provides a smooth finish typical of floor paints. The product has excellent colour durability and its white tint will not turn yellow, unlike with alkyd paints.

Teknofloor Aqua can be tinted into the shades of the revised Teknofloor Floor Coating Colour Chart and the Teknos Interior Colour Chart.









TEKNOFLOOR AQUA Floor Paint

A waterborne semi-gloss acrylic paint for concrete and wooden surfaces that are new or have been previously treated using acrylic or alkyd varnishes or paints.

Painting product group: 651 (MaalausRYL 2012). Painting material groups: 39.1 and 39.2 (MaalausRYL 2001). Gloss level/group: Semi-gloss/gloss group 3. Spreading rate: 7-9 m²/l. Thinner: Water. Application method: Brush and roller. Tint: Basic paints 1 (white) and 3, and pre-tinted paint T4017. Can be tinted into the shades of the Teknofloor Floor Coating Chart and the Teknos Interior Colour Chart. Package sizes: 0.9 I, 2.7 I and 9 I.
