

Information on mandatory labelling for articles treated with TEKNOL AQUA 1414-01

When an article has been treated with wood preservative and its biocidal properties (protection against e.g., wood destroying or discolouring fungi) are claimed, below instructions, which are in accordance with the Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation - BPR), effective as of 1 September 2013, must be followed¹:

The person responsible for the sale of treated articles, such as doors and windows, shall label such articles with the details stated here for TEKNOL AQUA 1414-01 in the FACT SHEET below.

Labelling shall be clearly visible, easily legible and of suitable permanence. When necessary, due to the size of function of a treated article, labelling shall be printed on the packaging, the user guide or on the guarantee.

e) Special precautions for articles treated with TEKNOL AQUA 1414-01:

A topcoat must be applied to treated wood. The topcoat cannot contain a film or wood preservative. The topcoat must be classified as stable according to European Standard EN 927-2. Treated wood is not intended for uses involving contact with food, feed, drinking water or livestock.
