

Teknos GBI Brexit regulations Q&A

This document will guide you through key questions concerning the impact of the Brexit transition coming to an end on 31st December 2020. Teknos GBI will share how they have actioned these concerns and the processes going forward.

The transition period comes to an end on 31st December – will this cause a delay in receiving / supplying goods?

There has been some press to suggest that delays at the borders may be likely. To mitigate the risk of delays, several actions have been taken:

- Regular stock holding has been increased by 2 weeks
- Fast moving stock holding has been increased by 4 weeks
- We have appointed an intermediary who will deal with all customs paperwork. This will ensure that our delivery trailers clear customs **before** they reach the border.

Are you prepared for changes in regulation including CLP and REACH?

A lot of work has been done with Group Companies to ensure that all substances are transferred from EU REACH to UK REACH within the time allocated. The majority of EU CLP Regulation will continue to be applied under GB CLP. Our packaging will comply with GB CLP as soon after 1st January 2021 as practically possible.

Does Teknos UK & Ireland have an EORI number?

Yes. We have been allocated EORI and XI EORI numbers for both locations.

Will Teknos GBI complete full customs declarations themselves or use an Intermediary?

RIF Worldwide have been appointed as Teknos GBI's Intermediary; they will take care of all customs declarations and clearance.

Has Teknos GBI put in place arrangements to deal with the additional paperwork required on exporting GB to NI?

RIF Worldwide will complete this paperwork. Teknos UK are also registered with TSS (Trader Support Service).

What tariffs will be applied if an FTA is not reached?

Most of the product imported by Teknos GBI falls under commodity code 32099000 which is 6.0%.

What action has been taken to ensure compliance with the new UK GDPR?

A data controller has been appointed in the UK and in the EU. Our privacy notice will be updated to reflect this (contact Mary Treadwell, mary.treadwell@teknos.com for a copy of the privacy notice). The data flow between the UK and EU has been mapped to ensure full compliance.
