



7 TIPS TO HELP YOU WITH OUTDOOR PAINTING

HOW DO YOU CHOOSE THE RIGHT EXTERIOR COLOUR?

1 Your choice of exterior colour will be affected by the surrounding buildings, landscape, zoning regulations and the building's architecture, in addition to your own preferences.


2 When viewed from a distance, the painted exterior will appear slightly lighter and more saturated in colour than a colour sample viewed close up.



3 In addition to the surrounding landscape and buildings, the season and the time of day will affect the perception of colour, as will the weather.



4 It's advisable to select an exterior colour on the basis of a test on the building that will be painted. Tests should be sufficiently large and the layer of paint should be an opaque shade.





The best way to review alternative colours is to keep the test paint areas a good distance away from each other on different walls of the building.



5 The structure of the painted surface affects the perception of the colour. E.g. on a rough surface, the colour will appear slightly darker than on a smooth surface.

For your building to stand out from its surroundings, it's a good idea to use a light colour.



6 The light building will be visible from a greater distance than a darker building.
