Discolouration of Coated Joinery

Discolouration of coated joinery is one of the most common site complaints on newly installed factory finished joinery.

Milky discolouration in translucent systems can happen in cold conditions when the joinery has been wrapped or is stored in damp conditions. This discolouration will disappear within a few days of the joinery being installed as the residual moisture dissipates in to the atmosphere and the coating achieves full cure.

For opaque systems the issue will show itself as micro blistering but in severe cases the blisters can be much larger. Again, these will disappear as the moisture dissipates in to the atmosphere.
